He/she has an active role in pastorally supporting these students, as well as creating programs and providing resources that allow students to achieve their potential. In addition the Special needs/Gifted Education Coach works closely with teachers, building their capacity to individualise programs and activities and learning opportunities within the classroom.

The successful applicant will be responsible for:

- Establishing procedures to identify students with special needs and recommending strategies for support.
- Providing teachers with relevant information to ensure curriculum differentiation to cater for student needs.
- Overseeing the development and facilitation of all support and extension programs to meet the learning needs of students.
- Meeting prospective and current parents to provide information about the college's learning interventions.
- Assisting to modify assessment and reporting as and when required.
- Preparing documentation for government and ISV funding applications.

The successful candidate will possess:

- Registration with the Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT);
- Coaching or leadership experience within an educational setting;
- · Experience working with special needs children;
- A genuine passion for special education needs;
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to communicate effectively with students, parents and staff at all levels.
