 requirement even if picking up a form or paying fees all visitors must register their
 presence at the College.
- Parents are not permitted to enter the school buildings at drop-off or pick-up time but are welcome to meet their child outside.
- Students should not attend school with any symptoms of cold or flu. If symptoms develop while at school, you will be contacted to pick up your child. Students should only return to school when symptoms clear or after presenting medical clearance to the College.
