**OFFER CONFIRMATION FEE** (Adjusted in Term 1 fees) **\$ 200**

**Registration fee of \$150** is payable upon acceptance of enrolment by the College, and applies to each new enrolment. **Offer confirmation fee of \$200** per child to be paid to secure your children's spot, which will be adjusted against 2019 Term 1 fees.

## TUITION FEES PER ANNUM

School fees are payable in advance each term. Fees paid in advance for the full year by the due date, will attract a discount of 7.5% (this applies for tuition fees only and does not apply for those receiving concession). If a periodical payment is made through your Bank by Direct Banking into our account a discount of 5% will be allowed (including those who are on concession).

## COMPOSITE FEES PER ANNUM

Payable in advance each term. This levy includes library resources, Internet facilities, class sets, classroom worksheets, art materials used in the classroom, school diary, accident benefits, excursions (primary), lockers (secondary) etc.

**BUILDING FUND** - The building fund is very important to the development of our school facilities and we rely on the generosity of each family's payment for the benefit of our children's future. Annual Voluntary Payment for Capital Development per family \$200.00 may be paid every term at \$50 per term (Tax Deductible). Further donations may be made directly into our Bank Account (details given above). These donations will be specifically applied towards the new building facilities.

All international students need to pay the fees in full regardless of number of children in a family.

## CONCESSION (FAMILY ASSISTANCE SCHEME)

The College offers concession to low income and larger families. If you wish to apply for concession, please request the admin office for a FAMILY ASSISTANCE SCHEME form at the beginning of the year (before end of Term 1). Please see the schedule below to see if your income qualifies you for a concession (conditions apply if qualified for concession).

### Required document for assessment of your income:

- Income Statement – Pay Slips, Current Tax Return, Group Certificate or Employer Statement of Income
- Social Security letter from Centrelink
- Pension or Health care card
- Family Assistance Scheme Form duly filled and signed.

Concession will only be given to families who pay school fees regularly without any arrears.

## **BUS FEES PER TERM**

We recommend parents to bring their children to school. If you require bus service, bus fees should be paid in advance for a term. Parents are encouraged to use direct debit facility to pay bus fees to avoid situations of children being not picked by bus due to non payment of bus fees.

Bus service is not available for kinder students

## **OFFICER CAMPUS**

If you are eligible for government's Conveyance Grant, this can be applied against bus fee and the balance will be paid by parents. No concession for bus is allowed. Individual application form must be filled and signed and given to the Officer Campus admin office on time to obtain funds from the Department of Education.

## **OTHER COSTS**

**Uniform** - Obtain uniform list from the admin office.

**Books and stationery** - Obtain Books and Stationery list from the admin office.

**Camp and Excursion** costs are payable when organised for Middle and Secondary schools (Year 7 – 12). Camp costs are payable for primary (only excursion expenses are covered with composite fee for Prep to Grade 6).

**Food Tech/Art Tech** and other special subjects charges are payable separately.

**Laptop of \$90** per annum to be paid at the beginning of each year.

**Subject specific subscriptions** should be paid in advance to obtain relevant access to the required applications.

## **PLEASE NOTE**

One full term's notice (10 weeks) will apply for withdrawal or short-term absence (i.e. going overseas). Failure to provide one term's notice will result in one full term's fees being charged to your account. Withdrawal of students without settlement of all outstanding fees will be referred to a Debt Collector.

## **CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)**

This fund is for those applying for concessions and who hold a valid pension or health care card. Eligible students will receive a sum of \$225 for secondary student and \$ 125 for primary student from the Department of Education and Training (DET). This funds to be purely used for Camps, Sports & Excursion purpose.
