ENROLMENT FEES

A **non-refundable** enrolment processing fee of **\$150** is payable upon submission of an enrolment application form.

An enrolment confirmation fee of **\$200** per student is payable upon the acceptance of a student's enrolment. This will be adjusted against the student's first invoice.

SCHOOL FEES PER ANNUM

School fees are payable in advance on an annual basis. Fees that are paid in full, within the due date will be eligible for a 10% discount. Please note that this discount is only applicable for students on full local fees and is not for students who are eligible for concession fees.

BUILDING FUND

No discounts are applicable on international student fees.

BUS FEES

Bus services are provided to all students except kindergarten students. All students, including international students, should make payments in advance for the year.

Parents are encouraged to pay via direct debit to ensure non interrupted bus services during the year.

OTHER COSTS

- **Uniform, Books & Stationery:** The list can be obtained at the Admin Office.
- **Camps & Excursions:** Costs are payable when activities are organised for Middle and Secondary schools (Year 7– 12). Camp costs are payable for primary students (only excursion expenses are covered through composite fee for Prep-Grade 6).
- **Food & Art Technology:** The payments as per subject selection will need to be paid separately.
- **Subject specific subscriptions:** Payments for subject specific subscriptions are to be made in advance in order to obtain access to the material.
- **Ipads & Laptops:** The Annual fee for Ipads are \$135 and laptops are \$120. This annual fee is required to be paid at the beginning of each year for the duration of the contract.

FURTHER INFORMATION

NOTICE OF STUDENTS' ABSENCE OR WITHDRAWAL

Parents are required to provide 10 weeks notice in writing in regards to the withdrawal of enrolment or short term absences (eg- overseas travel).

Families who fail to provide adequate notice will be charged until the end of that corresponding term.

Any family that withdraws students without settling their school fees will be referred to a Debt Collector.

CONCESSION (FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME)

The school offers fee concessions to families facing financial hardship. Parents who wish to apply for a fee concession are required to submit a completed Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS) form along with all the required supporting documents before the end of Term 1. FAS forms can be obtained at the administration office at all campuses.

Each concession application will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Concession will only be granted to families who pay school fees regularly without any arrears.

Required documents for assessment of your income:

- Proof of income - Pay Slips, Current Tax Return, Group Certificate or Employer Statement of Income,
- Income statement from Centrelink,
- A copy of a valid concession card,
- A completed Financial Assistance Scheme form.

CONVEYANCE GRANT (OFFICER CAMPUS ONLY)

Parents at Officer campus who are eligible for Conveyance Grant can apply for this grant against bus fees. The balance of bus fees must be paid by parents. There is no concession for bus services.

The School's Conveyance Grants Scheme (SCAS) forms can be obtained at the administration office at Officer campus.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

The CSEF fund is for families who have a valid Pension/Health Care Card and students (16 years old or above) who have Youth Allowance Health Care Card/Disability Support Pension Card.

Eligible secondary students will receive \$225 and primary students will receive \$125 from the Department of Education and Training (DET). These funds can be used **ONLY** for Camps, Sports & Excursion purposes.

CSEF forms can be obtained at the administration office at all campuses.
