



STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY

1 RATIONALE

Student uniform is an essential part of Minaret College (the College) as it provides us with a sense of identity and belonging. Clothing should not be tight, oversized, or revealing.

2 POLICY STATEMENT

Students attending the College from Foundation to Year 12 are expected to wear the full and correct College uniform at all times. High standards are required with regard to dress and appearance and students are required to be dressed in the correct uniform while on campus, travelling to and from campus and when representing the College at all activities including but not limited to sporting events, community functions and excursions.

3 UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Parents/carers and teachers are responsible for ensuring students comply with the Uniform Policy requirements at all times. Prescribed student uniform is provided in Sections 4 and 5.

The following rules and guidelines are designed to assist students fulfil these requirements.

4 RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

- Minaret College bags are required for all students. Currently school bags are available in three sizes, suitable for Primary and Secondary School students.
- Black leather polishable shoes must be worn by all students. Refer to Section 10.
- White headscarves are compulsory for female students from Grade 3 to Year 12.
- Sport uniform is required for PE classes and sports activities.
- Hats or caps must be worn outdoor during Terms 1 and 4 (as per Sun Protection Policy).
- Uniform should be neat and kept in good condition.
- Uniform items should be marked with student names to enable easy return if misplaced.
- Facial hair on male students must be kept clean and tidy.

5 OPTIONAL UNIFORM ITEMS

- Headcover for boys during prayer
- Belt (black only)
- Plain black beanie (winter)
- Plain black scarf (winter)
- Plain black gloves (winter).

6 PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Jewellery and face piercings (eg. nose, eyebrows, lips)
- Apparent make-up, nail polish, nail extensions, fake eyelashes, tattoos, hair gel and colouring
- Sandals, canvas shoes, boots or other unsupportive footwear. Refer to Section 10 1 for samples.

7 PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM (F-6)

Primary Uniform

Both Boys & Girls

- A. White, black or grey socks
- B. Black leather shoes
- C. Minaret Hat
(Term 1 and 4 only)
- D. Green College jumper
- E. Bomber Jacket
- F. Black Short Shell Jacket with logo (optional for Year 5 & 6 only)
- G. Black Minaret Bag

Girls Only

- H. College dress
- I. White hijab and cap
- J. Black tights

Boys Only

- K. College grey trousers
- L. Long or short-sleeved white shirt (with logo)



8 SECONDARY SCHOOL UNIFORM (7-12)

Secondary Uniform

Both Boys & Girls

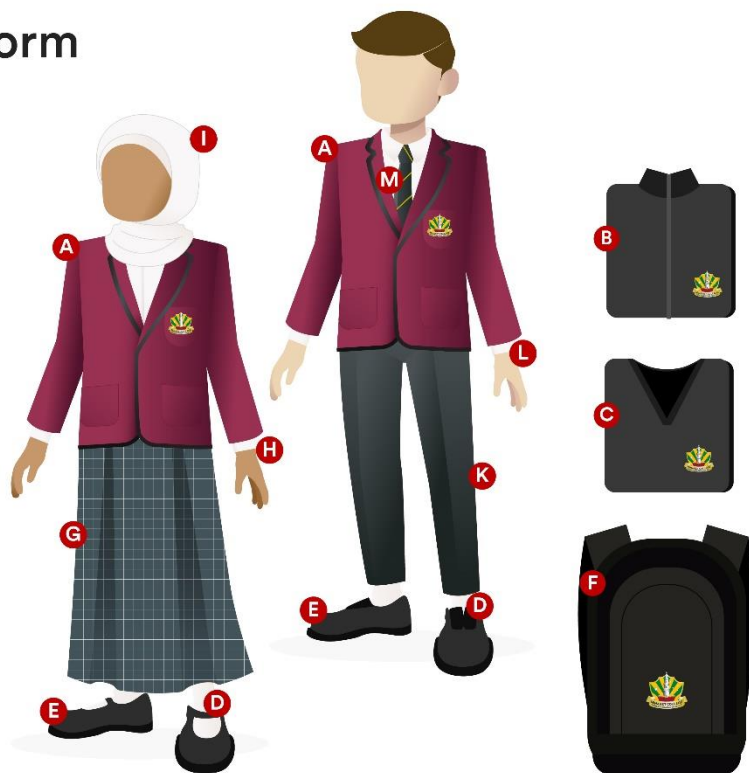
- A. College blazer (summer mandatory, winter optional)
- B. Black soft-shell jacket
- C. Black jumper
- D. White, black or grey socks
- E. Black leather shoes
- F. Black Minaret Bag

Girls Only

- G. College skirt
- H. Long-sleeved white shirt (with logo)
- I. White hijab and cap
- J. Black tights

Boys Only

- K. College grey trousers
- L. Long or short-sleeved white shirt (with logo)
- M. School tie
- N. Black belt



9 SECONDARY SCHOOL UNIFORM – YEAR 12S ONLY

In addition to standard school uniform, Year 12 students can wear custom-designed apparel (eg. jacket), which must be approved by the Head of Campus prior to ordering.

10 SPORTS UNIFORM

Sport uniform is required for PE classes (Foundation - Year 10), lunchtime activities, sports training and interschool sports activities.

Sports Uniform

Both Boys & Girls

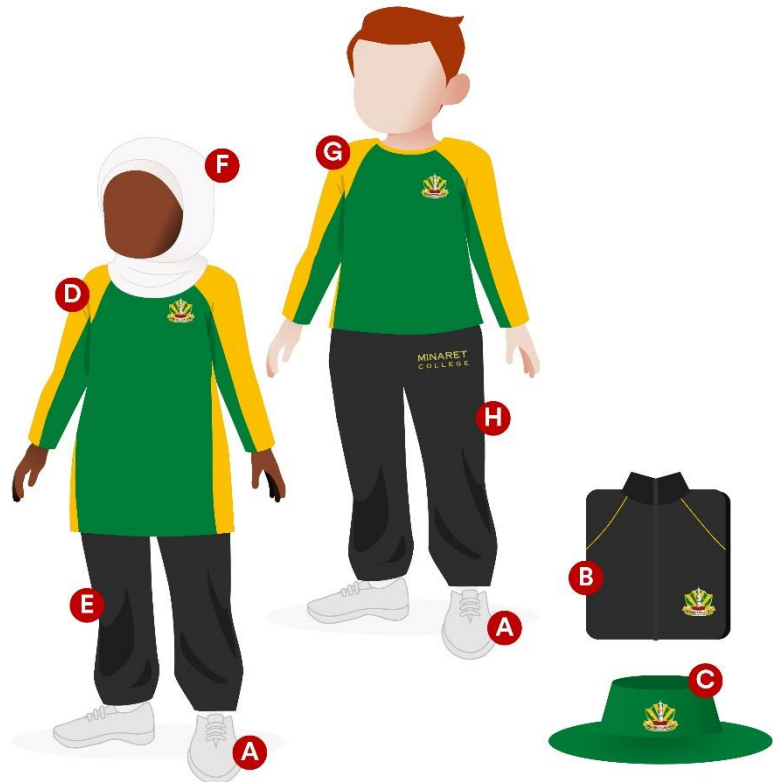
- A. Sports runners (no studs)
- B. Black sports jacket
- C. Minaret hat for primary students (Term 1 and 4 only)

Girls Only

- D. Girls Minaret Sports Top
- E. Long-length sports pants
- F. White hijab and cap

Boys Only

- G. Boys Minaret Sports Top
- H. Long or short-length sports pants



11 HAIR STYLE

The following guidelines apply to male students:

- Short and neat hairstyle
- Hair must be above the eyes, ears and shirt collar
- No extreme hairstyle, fashion cuts or colouring
- No hair products such as gel/mousse/cream/wax
- Minimum shaving level is number three and blended into the top.

These haircut samples DO NOT COMPLY with school policy.

Students with unacceptable hairstyles will be barred from lessons. Parents will be asked to come to the school to take them home.

Female students from Grade 3 to Year 12 are required to cover their hair appropriately by wearing a hijab (head cover).



12 EXEMPTIONS

The Head of Campus may exempt a student from meeting the uniform policy requirements upon receiving a written request from parents or carers. Relevant evidence (for example, medical certificate or letters from medical professionals) must be submitted with the application. Alternative arrangements will be agreed upon as deemed appropriate by the College and parents or carers.



13 BREACH OF UNIFORM POLICY

Where the Student Uniform Policy is breached, one or more of the following consequences may apply:

- Caution by a staff member (eg. Form Teacher, Year Level Coach or Head of School)
- Restorative conversation and counselling
- Contact with parents
- After-school detention
- Suspension/Expulsion

These steps are consistent with the Student Discipline Policy.
